

Even though stone and wooden houses have become more popular among the Eskimo, they still build the igloo for special occasions or while on a journey. <u>It</u> is quickly built and safe against any kind of weather. First a trench about 5 feet long and 20 inches <u>deep</u> in newly made snow drift. Then from the face of the trench, blocks are cut with knife. These are shaped so that they lean to inside. Circles of these snow blocks are put and cracks are filled in with soft snow.

When the igloo is complete they light a blubber lamp and make it burn as hot as possible. Then the door is closed with a block of ice and the snow begins to melt. When the door is opened the cold air enters quickly and the house is changed from a building of snow to a dome of ice. And it is known that a small igloo house can be built in two hours. Of course when the winter ends and the temperature rise, the igloo begins to melt.
